# Alignment with House Bill 2

The Department is amending the TCM HRPW program to include the additional HEART Initiative population (parent/caregiver with a Substance Use Disorder/Severe Disabling Mental Illness (SUD/SDMI) diagnosis who has a child zero through five years of age in the home ).

In accordance with appropriations established by the Montana State Legislature in 2025 in House Bill 2, TCM services will be expanded and provided to Medicaid eligible HRPW and HEART Initiative populations.

## **Current eligible population:**

- High-Risk Pregnant Women who meet the current HRPW Criteria.

## **Pending expanded population:**

- Pregnant women with SUD/SDMI diagnosis, or
- Parent/caregiver with SUD/SDMI diagnosis and has a child aged 0-5 living in the home.



# Current Status

Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA) was submitted to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) on March 17, 2026, with an effective date of January 1, 2026.

We continue to work with CMS to answer questions and await final approval currently.

## Included in SPA:

- Name change to Targeted Case Management for High-Risk Pregnant Women and Healing and Ending Addiction through Recovery and Treatment (TCM HRPW & HEART) Program
- Updated provider qualifications and alignment with other state TCM programs.



# Intersection Between TCM & PCMT

TCM HRPW & HEART Program changes relate to PCCM Redesign to Primary Care Montana (PCMT) .

## Current Policy

- PCMH & CPC+ providers are not eligible to enroll as a TCM provider
- Passport providers are eligible to enroll

## July 2026

PCMT Tier 1 & 2 Implementation

- PCMT providers (except T-HIP) can enroll as TCM provider

## July 2027

PCMT Tier 3 Implementation

- To be determined following additional policy discussions
