State Approval Rules – Revised/Updated

- Remove licensing requirements to reflect OIG rule changes
- Separate application process for each type of program (facility, individual, prevention)
- New rule for sanctions
- Rules are specific to type of program
- Cleaned up language/formatting

Application Process

Current

- Three approval rules
 - Prevention
 - Outpatient Treatment Providers
 - Chemical Dependency Programs
- Two applications (treatment & prevention)
- Applications indicate applicable rules

Proposed

- Three approval rules
 - Prevention (including early intervention)
 - Individual Outpatient Providers
 - SUD facilities (licensed by OIG)
- Three separate applications
- Applications referenced in each approval rule
- Applications indicate corresponding rules
- Applications clarify local need (required by MCA)

Current

- Administrative Management
- Acceptance of persons into Treatment
- Client Rights
- Organization and Management
- Personnel and staff
- OP components
- Day Treatment components
- IOP components

Proposed

- Organization and management
 - Annual self-evaluation of program
 - tracking of outcomes
 - Documentation must conform with Medicaid policy/rules for service and documentation requirements
- Program sanctions
- Client Rights
 - Individualized treatment plan
 - Appropriate level of care
 - No discrimination
 - Informed consent
 - Free from abuse
 - Access to records

Individual Providers

Current

- Administrative Management
- Acceptance of persons into Treatment
- Client Rights
- Organization and Management
- Personnel and staff
- OP components

Proposed

- Communicable Disease Control
 - TB, Hep, HIV, STD
- Confidentiality
 - HIPAA/ 42 CFR Part 2
- Abuse or Neglect requirements
- Must be a licensed addictions counselor
- Limited to billing for services under the scope of practice for their license
- These rules apply to prevention providers if they are providing early intervention services.
