Commissioner Allen Recognizes Mental Health Awareness Month: The

Rehabilitation Services Administration published a <u>Dear Colleague Letter (DCL 24-03)</u> [rsa.ed.gov] from Commissioner Allen in recognition of *Mental Health Awareness Month* and to highlight the importance of mental health and the power of the vocational rehabilitation (VR) program to help individuals with mental health conditions live fulfilling and meaningful lives.

Commissioner Allen also highlights mental health resources from a range of Federal government agencies and encourages the VR agencies to support participants as they navigate mental health-related barriers and seek competitive integrated employment and integration into the community.

<u>Presidential Leadership Scholars - Apply by July 14th</u> [presidentialleadershipscholars.org] Virginia VR Staff Provide Windmills Training to Partners: VA-DARS included a requirement in the Combined State Plan for state and community partners to improve service and instruction for individuals with disabilities. All provider staff members should be aware of how to greet and serve all individuals from "welcome." This includes accessible websites; front desk interactions; test accommodations upon disclosure of a disability; reasonable accommodations, assistive technology, and universal design practices for instruction and participation; and information referrals for services from other agencies and accommodation requests.

As part of their efforts to scale up inclusion and accessibility for students and individuals with disabilities, DARS staff have provided Windmills training to state workforce staff and adult education providers. The presentations have been a welcoming offering for non-educators and even educators who do not have any special education background or who have not thought about disability beyond diagnoses. The topics are timely, the events are interactive and prompt reflection, and our practitioners are learning alongside their workforce partners from other programs and other regions in the commonwealth.

NET POC Multi-state Collaboration: Inger assisted David Leon VA DARS NET POC and Matt Herron with pulling NET Representatives from Kentucky and Tennessee together to discuss strategies for collaboration on providing Windmills Training to a business partner that has a foot print in each of the states mentioned above. This was the first of several meetings necessary to provide a training that is consistent with the business request to train their hiring team as well as front line management and assistant managers. The business has locations in Georgia, Alabama as well as Kentucky, Virginia and Tennessee. More will be shared as the collaboration moves forward and we would like to thank the VR Directors and NET Points of Contact in these states for their support of building effective relationships and collaboration across the footprint of the business.
