The [White House Office of Science and Technology Policy \(OSTP\) \[click.icptrack.com\]](#) issued a request for information (RFI) seeking [input from the public to help inform the development of the Federal Evidence Agenda on Disability Equity \[click.icptrack.com\]](#). OSTP is asking the public for feedback to understand the full scope of inequities faced by people with disabilities and to identify gaps in current knowledge. This information will steer the development of the Federal agenda, which will ultimately support the government in making data-informed policy decisions to advance equity in all areas—including health, employment, education, and others—for people with disabilities.
