The VR-NET Partnership with the Veteran's Administration (VA) made it to the top five and took the top slot adding 27 new candidates as of July 11th. Texas, California, and Florida Blind continue to be in the top 5 and joining for the first time is Georgia. As states continue to add new candidates' applications continue to increase with 2250 job views so far this month. With the increase of 169,073 employment opportunities posted to this date.
