

Self Employment Assessment Decision Tree

You want to be self employed.

- A. What are the major work tasks in the business including management of the business?
- B. Do you have the knowledge and skills necessary to perform the tasks? Physically, mentally and in practicality (Possibly complete physical, mental, skill or other assessments.
 - a. If yes, skip to C.
 - b. If no, Can the tasks be successfully modified or can/will others perform some tasks, making the venture possible? Will training make the venture possible?
 - i. If yes, skip to C
 - ii. If no – “Do something else”
- C. Will you be able to maintain necessary food, clothing, shelter and survival needs as a business is started?
 - a. If yes, skip to D.
 - b. If no – “I don’t think this is going to work!”
- D. Write the business plan or modified business plan, obtain consultation and then proceed to IPE if appropriate. (A business plan must be written prior to the completion of rehabilitation plan or funding services.)
 - a. If approved, skip to E.
 - b. If No –
 - i. Rewrite?
 - ii. Move on to another plan?
- E. Write Rehabilitation Plan (IPE) to proceed with services.
