REIMBURSEMENT OF CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Medicaid Reimbursable Targeted Case Management Services

Case management services delivered in accordance with the federal authorities governing targeted case management services as an optional service under a Medicaid state plan are reimbursable with Medicaid monies. Montana has implemented targeted case management services for eligible persons with an intellectual/developmental disability who are 16 years of age or older or are enrolled in the Developmental Disabilities 1915(c) 0208 Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Comprehensive Waiver. A person with developmental disabilities must be Medicaid eligible before the state may use Medicaid monies to reimburse any of the case management services provided to that person.

Those case management services that are reimbursable with Medicaid monies fall within the following core activities: 1) assessment/evaluation of service needs, 2) development of the care plan to address the service needs, 3) referral and linkage to service providers to address the needs identified in the care plan, and 4) monitoring/follow-up to ensure the needs are being met.

Availability of Case Management Services

The Department contractor that delivers targeted case management (TCM) services shall provide those services to eligible members throughout the state.

Reimbursement

TCM services are reimbursed on a per member per month basis that is inclusive of all case management services and contacts.

The case management monthly rate is all inclusive and is billed for every month the member is enrolled in case management, whether or not any specific case management services are provided. The monthly rate is billable using the following fee schedule.

The cost of providing Targeted Case Management through State employees is approximately \$35.00 per hour. Data showed that over the course of the year, individuals receive about 2 hours of case management service per month. Based on this assessment and the funding available, the monthly rate of \$85.57 per member, per month was established.

Calculation of Rate Reductions Due to Insufficient Funding

If funding is insufficient to support the above calculated rate, then the rate will be decreased until the rate is at a level that can be funded sufficiently.
