

DDP 0208 DD Comprehensive Waiver Service Definitions

Effective 7/1/13

3. Assisted Living

Payments for services rendered in an assisted living facility, including personal care, homemaker services, medication oversight, social and recreation activities, 24 hour on site response staff to meet the unpredictable needs of individuals and supervision for safety and security. Separate payment will not be made for those services integral to and inherent in the provision of the personal care facility service.

This service is targeted to those individuals with a developmental disability whose specific condition and/or physical conditions preclude placement in a less restrictive setting. Persons in this service option are not precluded from attending DD waiver-funded work/day or supported employment options.

Specify applicable (if any) limits on the amount, frequency, or duration of this service:

Separate payment is not made for homemaker or chore services, personal supports, residential habilitation, residential training supports, live in care giver or personal care services furnished to a person receiving assisted living services, since these services are integral to and inherent in the provision of assisted living services.

The waiver will not cover activities which are otherwise available under section 110 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the IDEA (20 U.S.C. 1401 et seq.), or EPSDT.
