SUBJECT: Whole Milk Yogurt Not Ringing Up Correctly for WIC

Thank you for your support of the Montana WIC Program. There is a problem with our system with whole milk yogurt that is cancelling transactions of all WIC foods.

WIC families are now allowed to get *low fat* and *whole* milk yogurt. When they are in the same transaction, Montana's EBT processor is returning an error message that prohibits anything from going through (usually says "Insufficient Units").

WIC families must be able to redeem their benefits for both low fat and whole yogurt, but when they are purchased together the transaction will fail. This issue affects all retailers and all whole milk brands.

Whole milk yogurt must be purchased in its own transaction for WIC.

If it is combined with other items, it will not go through.
