This initiative is funded by the Montana Bright Futures: Birth to Five Project

Objectives

This one-time opportunity for financial assistance is being offered to workers providing direct care to children in registered and licensed facilities in the state of Montana. Workers and families making up to 250% of the Federal Poverty Guideline (FPL) are eligible to receive funds under this program. This program will provide up to 12 months of financial assistance to defray the cost of childcare. Under the program, childcare copays are capped at \$100/month.

- · Parent must work in a childcare facility
- Provide direct care to children
- · Work at least 60 hours a month
- Montana Resident
- Childcare provider is licensed or registered
- · Comply with Child Support
- · Children must 12 and under
- Be at or below 250% of FPL. Maximum monthly income by family size is below.
