Soap and water Wipe with a paper towel	Sanitize with bleach solution (3/4 tsp bleach per quart of water)* Allow to air dry or to remain on surface for at least 2 minutes, then wipe with a paper towel	Disinfect with bleach solution 1/4 c per gallon of cold water (1 tbsp per quart of water)* Allow to air dry or to remain on surface for at least 2 minutes, then wipe with a paper towel
All surfaces	Food area surfaces Food preparation Tables Highchairs and trays Child Care areas Toys, pacifiers, etc. Shelves, counters, etc. 	Door & cabinet handles Toileting/Diapering areas

^{*}Bleach measurements may need adjusted based on the manufacturer strength. Adjust measurements, as necessary, to stay within the 30-200 ppm range for sanitizing and 600-800 ppm for disinfecting based on County Sanitation requirements.

All surfaces should be cleaned first AND then sanitized or disinfected.

Sanitizing and disinfecting products should not be used in close proximity to children.
