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**Overview**

To qualify for Tribal IV-E, child care is referred by Child and Family Services Division (CFSD). A child is may be eligible for a Tribal IV-E Best Beginnings Child Care Scholarship through the day before the child's 18th birthday.

Children referred by CFSD must use providers listed in 37.80.101(2). A Regional Administrator must approve the use of a Relative Care Provider (RCP). Children referred by CFSD cannot receive payment for care provided in the child's home.

If CFSD indicates a child has a special need on the application, a referral to the Professional Development Specialist will be made.
