Certificates of Completion

Create a certificate that can be issued automatically upon completion of a program or group of activities. There is a custom certificate plug-in option, but you do have the ability to redesign the certificate as well.

- Create a certificate by clicking the add activity or resource button → Custom Certificate and build the certificate in the screen that comes up. Things to note:
 - Options: Change to yes if you want the student and/or teacher emailed when a student receives a certificate.
 - Issue Options: Delivery recommend changing to "Send to Browser and Force
 Download" so that student does not navigate away from page and lose their certificate.
 - Options: require time in course to receive a certificate if applicable
 - Restrict Access: Add restrictions (such as a required grade) to receive certificate
- Edit/Customize the Certificate
 - Select the certificate you just created from the main course page
 - o Click the settings gear icon in the upper right corner → Edit Certificate
 - Change size to regular paper (8.5x11) landscape, change the width and height. They are in millimeters – W 279, H 216 is as close as you can come
 - Add Elements Click the option box with toggle arrows to choose an element → Click
 Add Element button, change font, size and color as needed → save changes
 - Repeat to include all the elements you want (Background Image, Text, Student Name, Date, Code, Teacher Name, etc.)
 - Use Text elements to add things like "On this day", "successfully completed", "Instructor"
 - Reposition Elements click the hyperlink under the elements to reposition them on the page like you want
 - Note: you can make changes to font, etc. in preview mode by double clicking
 - Click Save and preview, adjust as needed
 - Background Image once uploaded, click save then click the edit button next to the background image to choose the image as the background you want displayed (to the right of image – choose course image... Click Save
- Templates click the manage template button to build a custom certificate you can use and edit to meet your needs going forward.
