1a. Do you participate in community groups or other events in your community? Who usually goes with you?

Participant Response:

He goes to Farmers Market and sporting events (baseball, volleyball, basketball, soccer). He participates in various activities in the community with his family.

1b. Do you have the opportunity to visit friends who do not live or participate here? If yes, how often do you visit them?

Participant Response: Yes, whenever he wants. He has family that resides in Missoula he visits with at least once a week.

2. Are you able to go out and do the things you like to do, as often as you'd like?

Participant Response: Yes, whenever he wants. He likes to walk outside two times a day. Takes the public bus around town to places like Albertsons to grocery shop. He attends various activities in the community with family and has dinner at his sisters house.

3. How are options of things to do presented to you?

Participant Response: He thinks they do a good job of presenting options. There is an activities calendar. But activities are limited right now due to recent Covid outbreak. There are activities of Bingo sometimes. His choice if he attends. He has a scheduled laundry day but he can change the day if he wants. Same with room cleaning. He has a scheduled day but can request to change day or not have his room cleaned. Meals are on a calendar and he can request alternative options. There is the public bus schedule posted in the common room.

4. Do you have a way to get places when you want to do something outside your home?

Participant Response:

Yes, the public bus, family and sometimes assisted living van.

5. How often did you go out for fun in the past month?

Participant Response:

He went out 10 times. Went to his sisters house for dinner and watched a movie. He does that often. He watched a movie recently at the AMC movie theatre.

6. Do community groups come to your home for entertainment or social gatherings?

Participant Response:

He is not sure of any.

7.Do you have a paid job? Do you volunteer?

Participant Response:

8.Who chose the place you work?

Participant Response:

9.Do you have a way to get places you work?

Participant Response:

10.Do you take classes, training, or do something to help you get a job or a better job?

Participant Response:

11.Have you voted? (In a local, state, or federal election?) If not, would you like to?

Participant Response: “Yes, it’s very important!”. He votes in every election.

Participant Response:

Yes, anytime he wants. He has a phone in his room to call family and visits family often in-person.

13.Who decides your daily schedule?

Participant Response:

He decides his schedule. Schedules his day while drinking his cup of coffee in the morning.

14.If you leave to do something fun or go to work or an appointment, do you have to return by a certain time?

Participant Response:

No, he can return anytime he wants.

15.What happens if you choose not to leave your home during the day to attend work or other planned activities, or are otherwise unable to do so?

Participant Response:

Nothing, its his choice what he wants to do.

16. Who chose the place where you live?

Providence Hospital found him a SNF bed at MHR. He didn't want to go back to an apartment and want try living in an ALF. Wanted to try ALF. He was able to transfer from MHR SNF to MHR ALF.

Participant Response:

17. Do you like where you live?

Participant Response:

"Yes, I do!"

18. Do you know who to ask if you want to live somewhere else?

Participant Response:

"Don't need to know in my situation because don't want to leave."

19. Are you able to decorate your room? Did you choose the decorations in your room?

Participant Response:

Yes. His room decorated with houseplants, bulletin board with travel postcards from family, giant map of Montana, etc.

20. Do you choose what to buy with your money?

Participant Response:

"Yes, of course."

21. Can you get food at any time of the day, whenever you are hungry?

Participant Response:

Yes. He does a grocery shop biweekly with his family. He buys food to have in his room such as coffee, chips, sandwich supplies, etc. ALF meals are 3 times a day. PCA will get him food from pantry outside mealtime whenever he wants it.
