The Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS) is following up with more information regarding the issuance of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits. You have likely already received three notices in the last several weeks, and this is a fourth notice with new information about your SNAP benefits.

On November 13, 2025, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) directed states to issue full SNAP benefits for the month of November. This action follows the end of the federal government shutdown. All SNAP households will receive the full balance of their November benefits immediately. Households that previously received only a partial allotment due to the shutdown will now receive the remaining funds.

You likely received the full benefits on your card before this notice arrived. The funds can be used for food purchases as usual. You can call 1-866-850-1556 or visit www.mybnft.com to check your card balance.

As a reminder, you must continue to meet all program requirements in a timely manner:

- Report Household Changes: Continue to report any changes to your household circumstances.
- Complete Paperwork: Ensure you complete simplified reporting or recertification paperwork.
- **Submit Verifications**: Submit any requested verification documents to the Office of Public Assistance (OPA).
