



COMBINED MEDICAID 305-1

Age

Supersedes: FMA 304-1 (01/01/07)

Reference: 42 CFR 435.201, .222, .308 and .520; ARM 37.82.101; PL 104-193

Overview: Certain coverage groups have age-related limits to be eligible to receive Medicaid coverage.

ACA and Family Medically Needy:

- Children may be eligible through the month of their 19th birthday;
- Parents/Specified Caretaker relatives and pregnant women of any age may be eligible;
- Adults age 19 through 64 may be eligible for ACA Adult or ACA Adult Medicaid coverage
- Newborn children, eligible under the Child Newborn program, may be eligible through the month of their first birthday

ABD:

- Disabled children may be eligible through the month of their 18th birthday;
- Disabled adults may be eligible through age 64
- Adults, age 65 or older are considered 'aged'
- PRTF eligibility is limited to individuals age six through 17
- MWD eligibility is limited to individuals age 16 and older
- Autism waiver is limited to children age 15 months up to 8 years old
