

COMBINED MEDICAID 306-1 Managed Care Program

Overview: 'PASSPORT to Health' is a managed care program designed to provide quality medical care to Montana Medicaid clients. Under the managed care program, Medicaid clients must choose a PASSPORT provider to serve as their primary care provider. A PASSPORT provider is a doctor, clinic, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant who has agreed to help manage the client's health care.
