

**NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF LETTERS OF INTENT FOR APPLICATION
FOR CERTIFICATE OF NEED**

During the month of May, 2026, the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services received the following Letters of Intent to apply for Certificates of Need:

1. Benefis Senior Services Westview Senior Care Center, Great Falls – to establish long-term care services in Cascade County. Estimated \$13,065,106 amount of capital expenses are reported. **REVIEWABLE**

Any person who wishes to apply for a Certificate of Need in competition with any of the above-listed reviewable applicants must submit a Letter of Intent that meets the requirements of state law and rules, and requests comparative review, early enough so that the Department receives it no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 9, 2026.

INFORMATIONAL HEARING: Any affected person (an applicant for a certificate of need, a health care facility located in the geographic area affected by the application, an agency that establishes rates for health care facilities, or a third-party payer who reimburses health care facilities in the area affected by the proposal) may request an informational hearing on any of the reviewable proposals listed above by writing to Michelle Truax, Inspector General, Office of Inspector General, 2550 Prospect Ave Suite 300, PO Box 202953, Helena, MT 59620-2953.
