



## Changes to COVID-19 Test Result Reporting Process in Montana- **ACTION REQUIRED**

Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services (MTDPHHS) will deactivate the COVID-19 test result reporting platform Formstack at 11:59 MST on March 31, 2024. Partners currently using Formstack to report their COVID-19 test results should transition to an alternate reporting platform as soon as possible to prevent disruptions in data transmission to MTDPHHS.

COVID-19 is a reportable condition in Montana as established in Administrative Rule of Montana ([ARM 37.114.203](#)). Anyone who knows or has reason to suspect that a case, hospitalization, or death due to COVID-19 has occurred is required to report this information to their local health department immediately ([ARM 37.114.201](#)).

**Last Day to Access Formstack:** March 31, 2024.

### Reporting Platform Options:

- **SimpleReport**– SimpleReport is a free HIPPA-compliant tool developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and U.S. Digital Service (USDS) that makes it easy to report diagnostic test results for COVID-19 and other conditions to the public health department. - **Electronic Laboratory Reporting (ELR) Connection**– An ELR connection is a great option for facilities that have the technical capacity to send laboratory test results through a secure server-to-server connection using HL7. ELR fulfills reporting requirements for COVID-19 ([see ARM 37.114.201 \(5\)](#)).

## Additional Resources

### COVID-19 Reporting Requirements in Montana

COVID-19 is a reportable condition in Montana as described in [ARM 37.114.203 \(1\)](#). Any person, including administrators of a laboratory or other laboratory professional, who knows or has reason to suspect that a case of a reportable disease or condition defined in [ARM 37.114.203](#) exists must immediately report to the local health officer the information specified in ARM [37.114.205](#).

- All positive molecular (e.g., NAAT and PCR) testing is required to be reported to the local and state health departments.
- All positive antigen testing done with CLIA oversight (e.g., in the presence of a provider or someone trained to administer a COVID-19 antigen test) is required to be reported to the local and state health departments.
- Individuals testing positive with an over-the-counter antigen test are not required to report unless instructed by their employer. MTDPHHS has a self-report page available for individuals looking to report their rapid antigen test result.
