1.) Login to <a href="https://login.mt.gov/">https://login.mt.gov/</a> and click on your name in the upper right corner of your Apps page, and you'll get a drop-down like this:



2.) Click on Settings and look for Security Methods on the right side. Click on Set up and follow the instructions

## Logging into MIDIS using Okta Verify

1. Access MIDIS using this link: <u>https://app.montana.nbs.cdc.gov/nbs/login</u> When you get the login page that usually sends you the email, click "Verify with something else"



2. When it then prompts the options, click "Select" next to Okta Verify
