3. In the **Basic Filter** tab, select your **disease(s)** of interest. To select multiple diseases, press the **Ctrl key** while you select the diseases.

4. In the **Advanced Filter** tab, if you don't change anything you will generate a list of all your cases for that particular disease for all years.

5. To limit to only 2018 cases:
  - a. In the **Advanced Filter** tab:
    - i. Select **Field=MMWR Year, Logic=Equals, Value=2018**
    - ii. Press the **INSERT** button
  - b. You will see “MMWR Year Equals 2018” added to the Advanced Criteria List.


