

What do I do if I'm notified about a case of Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in children (MIS-C) from a medical provider or healthcare facility?

1) Review [information](#) about MIS-C.

2) Gather general information about case patient. CD Epi needs the following information:

- Patient name
- DOB
- Address
- Race and ethnicity
- Any tribal affiliation
- Recent COVID-19 illness or exposures
- Vaccination status

3) Have provider fill out [this worksheet](#) for the case patient. Directions on how to fill out the form are [located here](#). If the provider is unable to fill out the worksheet, this data can be pulled from the medical records. We must have this information to submit to the CDC. If the provider or county needs assistance to collect information from the medical record, please reach out to Jessica Lopeman: 439-6631.

4) Start a case investigation for "Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome (MIS) COVID-19" in MIDIS. **This is in addition to the COVID-19** investigation. Persons with MIS-C should have BOTH investigations in MIDIS.

1. Under "Events" tab, click "Add New" under investigations.



2. Under "Please select a condition" select "Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome (MIS) COVID-19."

3. Press submit and fill out pertinent information. There is a significant amount of data under the “Clinical” and “Studies” tabs that will need to come from the case patient’s medical records.

5) You may e-pass the worksheet to Jessica Lopeman (Jessica.lopeman@mt.gov) for help with getting all the information into MIDIS. In order for Jessica to enter information into the MIS-C investigation, an investigation in MIDIS must be created first. Please complete this step prior to e-passing the form.
