

Assisted Living Facility and Long-Term Care Facility Cases and Hospitalizations

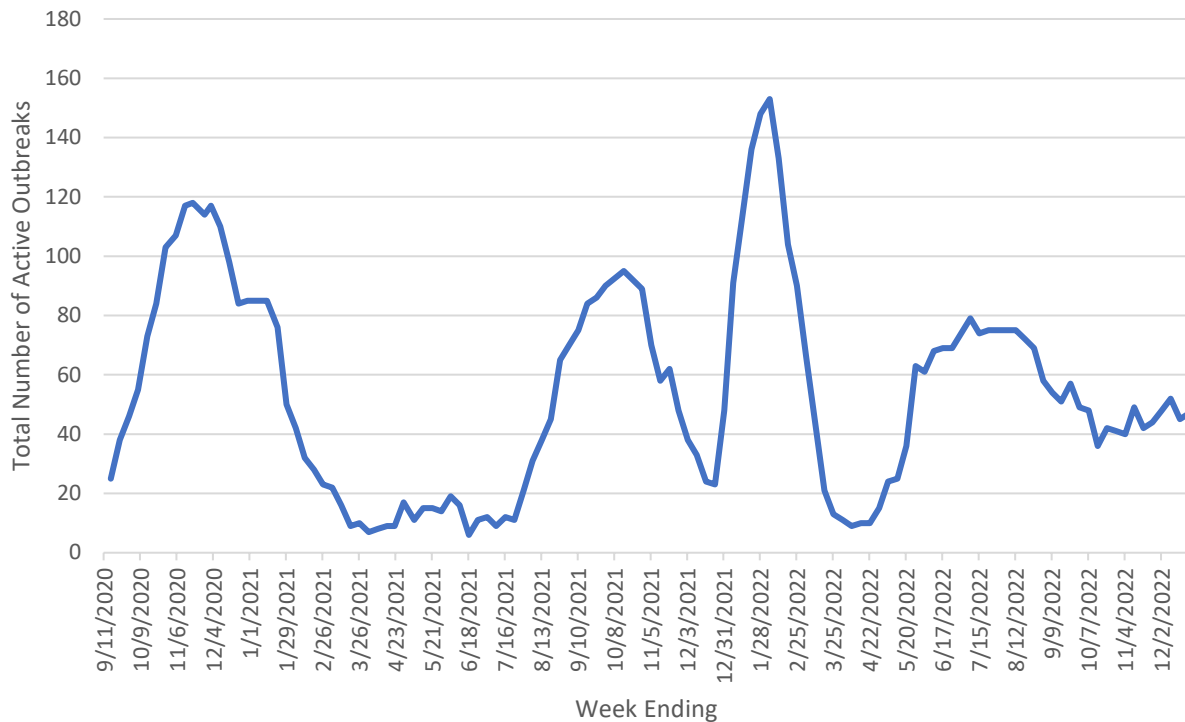
There are 71 long-term care facilities (LTCFs) and 211 assisted living facilities (ALFs) in Montana. As of December 23, 2022, there have been 14,950 cases associated with ALFs and LTCFs since the beginning of the pandemic, which comprises 5% of the total number of COVID-19 cases Montana has reported. There have been 688 COVID-related deaths associated with ALFs and LTCFs in Montana, which accounts for 19% of the COVID-related deaths that Montana has reported since the beginning of the pandemic. Table 3 summarizes recent COVID-19 activity in Montana ALFs and LTCFs.

Facilities that have identified a case of COVID-19 in a resident or staff member within the last 14 days are considered to be actively responding to an outbreak. Figure 8 displays active outbreaks in ALFs and LTCFs in Montana by week.
