

## Weekly COVID-19 Update in Montana (as of 10/1/2021)

This report is a weekly snapshot of COVID-19 activity in Montana. Data are analyzed based on information available as of October 1, 2021. Data are provisional and expected to change as more information is received.





Figure 2. COVID-19 Deaths by Report Date and Date of Death – Montana, 11/1/2020 – 10/1/2021


## Vaccine Data

Montana began vaccinating individuals in mid-December 2020 with a phased process: Phase 1A on December 14, 2020, Phase 1B on January 19, 2021, and Phase 1B+ on March 8, 2021. Vaccinations were opened to all Montanans age 16+ on April 1, 2021 and expanded to all Montanans age 12+ on May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021. To date, 1,010,088 doses have been given across the state and 53% of the eligible population is considered fully vaccinated.





#### Figure 3. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Week – Montana, as of 10/1/2021





## Variant and Breakthrough Cases




Figure 6. Percent of COVID-19 variants in sequenced samples by collection date, Montana 10/5/2021

Figure 6 displays the percentage of the most common SARS-CoV-2 lineages detected each week, among all samples sequenced that were collected that week. There were 4,086 samples that were sequenced and had their lineages reported to <u>GISAID</u> since September 2020; figure 5 displays the number of specimens sequenced by week. A variant is a lineage that has one or more mutations that differentiate it from other lineages in circulation. CDC updated their COVID variant classification system recently. Delta is the only Variant of Concern at this time, and it is the dominant circulating strain in Montana. Of specimens collected and sequenced in September and October, 563/564 (99.9%) are Delta. Aside from Delta, all other former variants of concern and interest have been re-classified as Variants Being Monitored. The overall trends in variants shows that, March through June, the Alpha variant (light yellow) was predominant. Beginning in July, the Delta variant (dark orange) has been detected most often among sequenced samples and is currently the dominant variant in Montana.

A breakthrough COVID-19 infection is defined as a positive SARS-CoV-2 collected ≥14 days after completing the primary COVID-19 vaccine series of an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine. Depending on the specific vaccine administered, completion of series could be one or two doses of vaccine. As of 10/5/21, Montana reports 7,376 cases of confirmed breakthrough disease, which includes 422 hospitalizations and 88 deaths. Over the past 8 weeks (August 7 – October 1) the number of cases among unvaccinated individuals was 4.9 times higher than the number of cases among vaccinated individuals; the number of hospitalizations and deaths among unvaccinated individuals were 5.0 and 4.0 times higher, respectively, compared to vaccinated individuals.

## Hospitalizations and Deaths and Vaccination Status

COVID-19-related hospitalizations and deaths were analyzed between **April 1 and October 1** to review vaccination status. Since the beginning of April this year, 86% of Montanans who were hospitalized and 79% of those who died were unvaccinated at the time of infection (Table 3). Of the 2,885 individuals who were hospitalized during this time period, 42 (2%) were <18 years old, 491 (17%) were 18 to 44 years old, 1,012 (35%) were 45 to 64 years old and 1,340 (46%) were  $\geq$ 65 years old.

Additionally, COVID-19-related hospitalization and death data from **August 7 – October 1** (last 8 weeks) were analyzed to review vaccination status. Eighty-three percent of Montanans who were hospitalized and 80% of those who died had not received a COVID-19 vaccine (Table 4). Of the 1,810 individuals who were hospitalized during this time period, 30 (2%) were <18 years old, 312 (17%) were 18 to 44 years old, 617 (34%) were 45 to 64 years old and 851 (47%) were  $\geq$ 65 years old.
