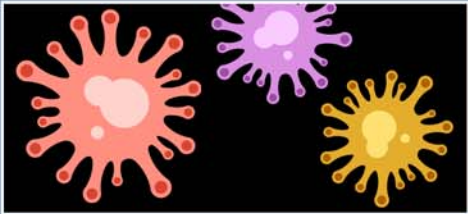

TEST
