

Body Art Establishments: COVID-19 Requirements and Recommendations

Requirements

- A face covering that covers the mouth and nose shall be worn at all times in indoor spaces open to the public. Face coverings shall be provided for all employees and volunteers. All points of entry open to the public shall have a clearly visible sign posted stating: "Mask or face covering use required for ages five and older."

Recommended best practices



OPERATORS

- 6 feet distance and physical barrier between workstations and patrons
- Frequently touched surfaces be cleaned and sanitized as often as possible
- Follow normal use and sterilization procedures for multi-use utensils and equipment between patrons
- Follow normal use and disposal procedures for single-service articles
- Screen worker and patron forehead temperature with infrared thermometer before start of workday and/or screen for symptoms (more than 96.1°F suggests possible fever)
- Prohibit non-essential worker and visitor access onto premises if possible
- Consider signage for patrons directing patrons to:
 - Maintain 6 feet distance between people
 - One-way directional foot traffic in lobby and aisles
- Shielding protection between guest and front-desk worker
- Train workers for:
 - Sanitation and hygiene procedures
 - COVID-19 symptom awareness
 - Incident response plan for cleaning and sanitizing regarding a positive COVID-19 test or case

WORKERS

- Beware of illness omission symptoms
- Wear surgical face mask if possible
- Follow normal use and disposal procedures for single-use gloves
- Wash hands when contaminated or suspect of contamination
- Report illness symptoms to supervisor
- Do not work and stay home if ill
- Minimize contact time with patrons when possible

PATRONS

- Vulnerable people to COVID-19 should not use body art services
