37.112.125 Equipment and Supplies

- (1) clean, good condition

37.112.131 Sterilization of Equipment & Jewelry

- (1) instruments wrapped and autoclaved
- (2) jewelry sterilized
 - (a) individually wrapped and autoclaved
 - (b) from supplier wrapped and autoclaved
- (3)(a) packaging and test indicators used
- (3)(b) autoclave cycle 20 min/15 lbs pressure/250° F
- (3)(c) package dated & initialed; used within 6 months

- (1) aftercare verbally and in writing
- (2) sterile instruments & aseptic technique used
- (3) required handwashing procedure
- (4) personal hygiene requirements for artist
- (5) single use razors
- (6) gloves replaced after shaving
- (7) antiseptic cleaning of skin before procedure
- (8) single use marking device
- (9) gloves used during procedures
- (10) glove replacement after contamination
- (11) sterile, single-use materials to absorb blood
- (12) antiseptic cleaning of skin after procedure; sterile absorbent bandage applied to tattoo

- (1) records kept 3 years

37.112.142 Client Record

(1) client record must be kept for each client

37.112.147 Training

(2) current first aid & BBP certificates required

37.112.150 License Requirement & Display

- (1) license required; not transferrable
- (2) valid license posted in conspicuous place

37.112.158 Restrictions & Prohibitions

- (1) conditions under which procedure cannot Occur (alcohol/drug use, etc.)
- (2) under 18- parent/guardian present

37.112.163 Tattooing: Pattern Transfer

(2) product used for pattern transfer- prevent contamination; single use

37.112.163 Tattooing: Colors, Dyes & Pigments

- (1) reputable supplier; labeled with manufacture name and lot number
- (5) ink cups used only once
