

Add Varicella Immunity Quick Reference Guide

Steps to Follow:

1. Search and select a patient record.
2. Click View/Add, located under the Vaccinations panel.
3. Click Special Considerations, located above the forecaster.

4. Select Contraindication, using the radio button.
5. Select Varicella for Vaccine.
6. Select “History of Varicella Infection” or “Laboratory Evidence of Immunity” for Contraindication.
7. Select Permanent.
8. Option to Add Additional Disease Information.
9. Select Save.

Note: If “History of Varicella” is saved, the word *History* will display in vaccine column for varicella on the View/Add screen. If “Laboratory Evidence of Immunity” is saved, the word *Immunity* will display in the vaccine column for varicella on the View/Add screen.
