

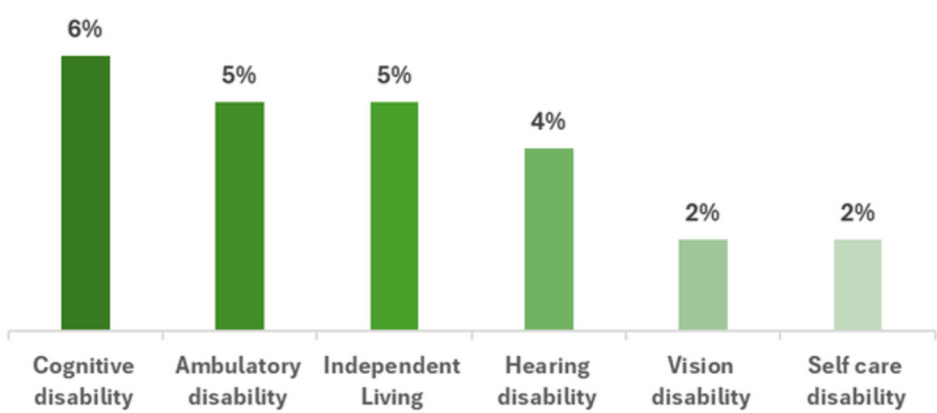

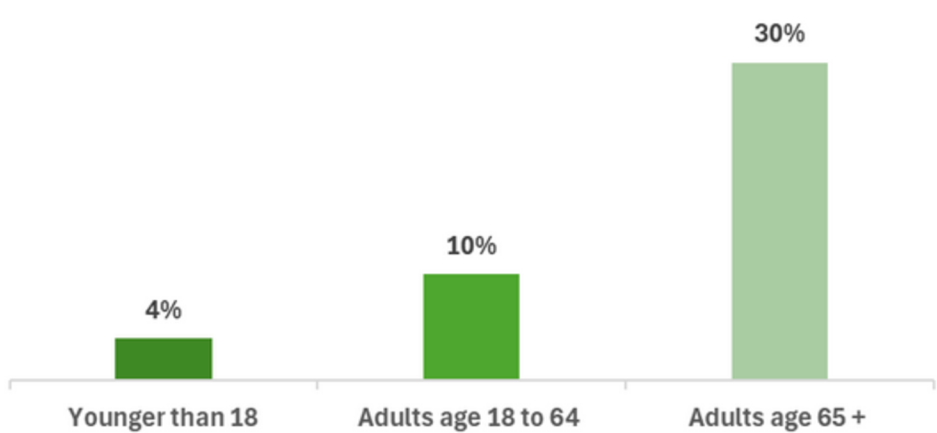

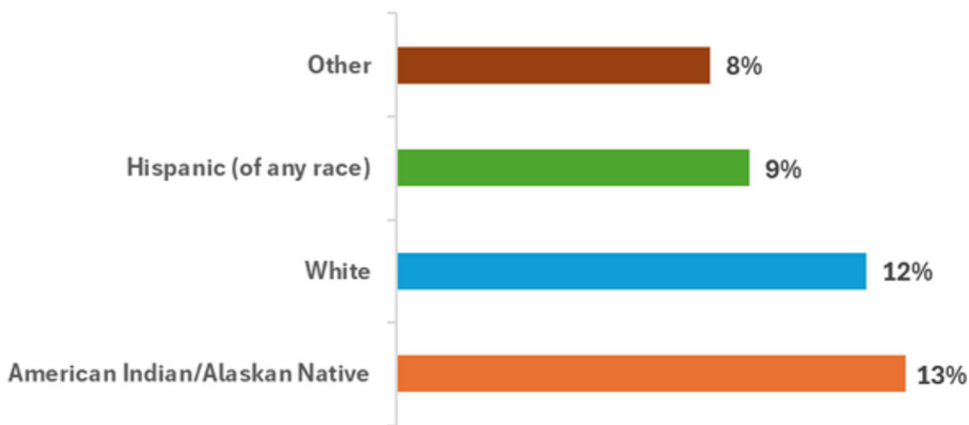
Percent of Adults with Disability by Disability Type

Employment

Missoula County employment status for adults with disability:

- **55%** Employed
- **7%** Unemployed
- **38%** Out of the labor force

Veterans

Missoula County Veteran status for adults with disability:

- **28%** of Veterans with disability
- **15%** of people with disabilities are Veterans

Poverty

Missoula County poverty status for adults with disability:

- **22%** of people with disabilities live in poverty
- **23%** of people in poverty live with disability

Institutionalization

Percent of total population in institutional group quarters in Missoula County:

- **1%** in institutional group quarters
- Among that 1%,
 - **36%** in correctional facilities
 - **53%** in nursing facilities
