# Overview of the HPP

- The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) funds the HPP through cooperative agreements.
  - Currently, we are awaiting a new notice of funding opportunity (NOFO).
- HPP is the primary source of federal funding for health care system preparedness and response and, **in collaboration with state and local health departments**, prepares health care delivery systems to save lives through the development of health care coalitions.










