History of HPP






Overview of the HPP

- The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)
 Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) funds the HPP through cooperative agreements.
 - Currently, we are awaiting a new notice of funding opportunity (NOFO).
- HPP is the primary source of federal funding for health care system
 preparedness and response and, in collaboration with state and
 local health departments, prepares health care delivery systems to
 save lives through the development of health care coalitions.
