Smokefree Housing Policies

This course will show you how smokefree housing policies can protect public health, make properties easier to rent and less expensive to maintain. This course is designed by the Montana Tobacco Use Prevention Program – MTUPP - which is part of Montana's Department of Public Health and Human Services. MTUPP aims to reduce tobacco use by offering the Montana Tobacco Quit Line, reduce initiation of tobacco use among youth, and protect Montana citizens from dangerous exposure to secondhand tobacco smoke.
