BSW 729 Services: Extended State Plan Service: Respiratory Therapy

PURPOSE DEFINITION

Respiratory therapy includes direct treatment, ongoing assessment, equipment monitoring and upkeep, pulmonary education, and rehabilitation.

PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

A Respiratory Therapist must be licensed in accordance with state regulations and enrolled as a Medicaid BSW pprovider through Conduent.

A member's legally responsible person, relative and/or legal guardian may provide respiratory therapy if they are licensed in accordance with state regulations and are enrolled as a Medicaid waiver provider. through Conduent. Conduent verifies the provider is free of exclusions and criminal activity as part of the enrollment process.

GENERAL SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Any activities provided under this service must be tied to goals and objectives documented in the member's service plan.

SERVICE LIMITS

This service is available only to members 21 year of age and older._ Respiratory <u>T</u>therapy is available to members under the age of 21 as a <u>S</u>state <u>Pp</u>lan service under <u>the</u> Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) program.

PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

<u>A Respiratory Therapist must be licensed in accordance with state regulations and enrolled as a Medicaid provider.</u>

Individuals who are legally responsible for members may provide Respiratory Therapy if they are licensed in accordance with state regulations and are enrolled as a Medicaid provider.
