

### Staff Interview #1

### 1. How frequently did individuals go out for entertainment in the past month?

Staff Response: Four times this past month as a group. Individual outings vary. One resident's family takes her out 3-4 times a week. Another individual prefers to stay inside.

# 2. What types of community groups or other activities in the community do individuals engage in? Who do individuals usually go with? How do individuals get there?

Staff Response: Activities: A trip to Glacier National Park near Browning and St. Mary's. We have a lot of activities planned. We are hoping to have more indoor outings instead of outdoor this winter. One resident goes to church every Sunday. The community has a Senior Center.

#### 3.Do individuals have any activities they are required to attend?

Staff Response: Individuals are not required to attend activities.

### 4. How do individuals see or make plans with their friends when they wish?

Staff Response: Each resident has a personal cell phone and they communicate that way. There are no residents without a cell phone right now in the facility.

#### 5. How frequently can individuals see and/or communicate with their families.

Staff Response: Whenever, there are no restrictions.

#### 6. How do individuals get places when they want to do something outside of the home?

Staff Response: Usually, the bus. If a driver is unavailable, then the facility manager will take residents to a hair or chiropractor appointment. There is no public transportation available. Residents also have friends and family members assist with transportation.

#### 7.Do any individuals have a competitive, integrated, paid job or volunteer in the community.

Staff Response: Yes, there is one resident who likes to volunteer in the community as much as possible.

#### 8.Do individuals vote in local, state or federal elections?

Staff Response: One resident always votes but I am not sure about the others.

## 9. What happens if individuals choose not to leave their home to attend planned activities or are otherwise unable to do so?

Staff Response: If a resident can't go on activities, in room activities are provided such as crafts, coloring or crossword puzzles.

#### 10. How do individuals choose what to buy with their money and how do they go out and spend it?

Staff Response: The facility has a grocery list and staff will go out and get most things that are requested. Family members of residents will also get items.

#### 11. How do individuals dictate their daily schedule?

Staff Response: Individuals pick and choose what they want to do during the day. They don't have to partake and can do whatever they choose. Residents choose if they do their own laundry or request assistance.
