Attention Montana Healthcare Programs Providers!

Dear Providers:

Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS), is implementing Netsmart's Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) system to electronically verify the delivery of services for Medicaid members receiving personal care or home health care services to comply with the 21st Century Cures Act.

Netsmart is conducting a survey to determine which providers will use the State's EVV solution or use an Alternate EVV Vendor. Click on the survey link, <u>Montana Provider EVV Survey</u> to complete the survey for your organization. This is very important, and we encourage you to complete the survey as soon as possible. See https://mobilecaregiverplus.com/mt-dphhs/ for more information. Montana's EVV solution will be implemented in September 2023.

At end of the survey, organizations planning to use an Alternate EVV vendor will need to share an additional survey link with their Alternate EVV vendor. This survey allows Netsmart to gather information related to your Alternate EVV Vendor and register as an Alternate EVV Solution with Netsmart Mobile Caregiver+ for Montana Medicaid. Once your EVV vendor submits their survey, Netsmart will begin communicating with your vendor and provide next steps.
