The Montana SHIP (State Health Insurance Assistance Program) provides information, counseling, and assistance to Montana Medicare beneficiaries, family members, caregivers and local professionals.

The Montana SHIP is a statewide network of volunteers and staff who are trained to deliver the most current Medicare information available.

What is a SHIP Counselor?

The Montana SHIP has more than 150 certified counselors throughout the state. They are men and women of all ages who are trained extensively in the areas of Medicare, Medicaid, Social Security, health insurance and other related topics.

What are Medicare Assistance Programs?

- **Medicare Savings Programs (MSP)**, also known as QMB, SLMB, QI, can help pay Medicare Part A & B premiums, deductibles and co-insurance. There are income/resource and other eligibility requirements. Apply online at apply.mt.gov or contact a local SHIP Counselor for assistance.
- **Low-Income Subsidy (LIS)/ Extra Help**, can help with Medicare Part D premiums, co-payments, deductibles and coverage gap (donut-hole) assistance. There are income/resource and other eligibility requirements. Apply online at SSA.gov or contact a local Ship Counselor for assistance.
- **Big Sky RX Program**, can help pay Medicare Part D premiums up to a set amount. There are income and other eligibility requirements. There are no resource limits. You may contact Big Sky Rx at 1-866-369-1233 or contact your local Ship Counselor for assistance.

What are Medicare Preventive and Wellness benefits?

- "Welcome to Medicare" is a FREE preventive visit during the first year on Medicare Part B.
- Annual Wellness visit is a FREE preventive visit every year.
